OBJECTIVES

The overall objective of the programme is to foster international cooperation and knowledge exchange between academic institutions in Western Europe (Hamburg) and the Balkans (Skopje). Through this initiative, students and academic coordinators will work together to address the complexities of implementing resource-efficient and climate-neutral spatial planning in different cultural, geographical, socio-economic and urban contexts.

The programme involves up to 40 students, equally divided between Hamburg and Skopje, and four academic coordinators (5 students from the Faculty of Architecture–Skopje, Ss. Cyril and Methodius University in Skopje). During the second phase of the collaboration, the Skopje students will have the opportunity to learn about Hamburg-based solutions for creating sustainable urban spaces through lectures, site visits and exchanges with local students. Several groups of visiting students will actively engage with these topics through the analysis of the transferability and applicability of selected solutions from Hamburg in the context of Skopje. On the final day of the workshop, concepts will be discussed in a public presentation format.

WHO CAN PARTICIPATE

The call is open to students in the 4th and 5th year who have knowledge of designing wooden structures.
