


11-12.06.2019, SKOPJE

The first day of the Green City Unconference will enable participants to get to know each other, develop together the working part of the Programme and discuss the aimed and expected contributions of each group on the given topics, as well as to identify new topics within and beyond the previous selected. During each session, participants will also interact with administrative officials in order to understand current operational and legislative strengths and weaknesses at best, that will ease the process of identifying challenges and developing solutions. Experts on the topics from civil society and academia will also be present in order to provide support and engage whenever is needed.



The second day will focus more on the solutions part. Deputy mayors and official representatives from cities that are known as mobility champions and sustainable development leads in the region, will share their experience and be present to provide participants with practical insights into their work. The working agenda is planned to be closed with an interactive part where participants will meet and talk about the realization of their ideas with decision-makers and government representatives, including the mayor of City of Skopje, Mr. Petre Shilegov.
