Dear Madam / Sir,

With great pleasure we invite you to take part in our tenth edition, the Archiprix International Addis Ababa 2021! Even in these times of the corona pandemic Archiprix will continue its activities. To participate you have to select the best graduation project of your faculty completed after May 1, 2018 and invite the designer(s) to submit the project to us. See below for the steps you have to take. Archiprix International is a biennial event that presents the worlds' best graduation projects selected by universities and colleges teaching architecture, urban design and landscape architecture across the world. All projects are presented on our website and will be included in a major exhibition. A book cataloguing the projects will also be published. The web site [www.archiprix.org](http://www.archiprix.org) offers the latest news, a survey of all submitted projects of all editions, with links to the websites of participating schools. An international jury will assess all entries and on the 7th of May 2021 the Awards will be presented to the winners. All the designers of the submitted graduation projects can apply to participate in the Archiprix International Workshop in Addis Ababa in the ten days before the award ceremony. The Archiprix International 2021 is organised by Archiprix International, Rotterdam in cooperation with Addis Ababa University, Ethiopian Institute of Architecture, Building Construction and City Development (EiABC) and the faculty of Architecture of Delft Technical University which is involved in the organization of the workshops. All of the above is under the pretext that the current pandemic allows us to organize the physical events, otherwise we will be announcing digital alternatives of the activities along the way.

### Procedure for submission of your entry in 5 steps

1. The Chair of University SS. Kiril and Metodij Faculty of Architecture signs the reply form included with this letter. Please check the address details of the school and email the form back to us.
2. Select the best graduation project from your faculty.
3. Give the designer(s) of this graduation project the application form.
4. The designer uploads his/her details and a digital version of the project to the website.
5. The designer submits the project by post to Addis Ababa or uses a print service in Addis Ababa. The submission must contain the following: 6 panels, size A2 vertical (420 mm wide x 594 mm high x 3 to 10 mm thick).

**Registration deadline: 30 September 2020; submission deadline 31 October 2020.**

We also invite representatives of participating schools to the Archiprix International Award ceremony. ### STEPS FOR THE DESIGNER

1. Enter the project on the web site [www.archiprix.org](http://www.archiprix.org) and email the application form
2. Submit a web presentation of the project on our web-site; (8 images with 1 line of text each; 1 text page with the project statement of maximum 300 words, 1 credits page with passport photo. Pictures JPEG. See web-site for more details)
3. a) Send project panels by courier service at your costs to Addis Ababa University (the address and contact person for delivery will be given on the web page that opens after you log in at your personal project pages) OR  
b) Instead of sending your panels to Addis Ababa you can have the panels printed there for 36 Euros for 6 A2 panels, for further instructions log in at your personal project pages.
4. **IMPORTANT NOTICE** Check the shipping rules from your country; you should write on the shipping form: Digital prints for a competition. No commercial value. Value: 25 Euro. (higher values can cause problems at customs).

### THE SUBMISSION SHOULD CONTAIN THE FOLLOWING

- maximum 6 panels, A2 size (420mm x 594mm) vertical. Use the template that can be uploaded on our website [www.archiprix.org](http://www.archiprix.org). Write your username **P21-0519** on the package and on each panel followed by a number (1 to 6);
- submission must arrive at EiABC before 31 October 2020.
- Send high-res images for the book and a digital copy of your 6 panels with [www.wetransfer.com](http://www.wetransfer.com) to [office@archiprix.org](mailto:office@archiprix.org)
- do not send models!

**Participation is free of charge. The projects will be presented on the web site, a selection will be presented in a publication and a travelling exhibition. Designers of the submitted projects are invited to take part in the workshop. The submitted material will not be returned after the exhibition.**
