



WEST FACADE M = 1:150




NORTH FACADE M = 1:150



SOUTH FACADE M = 1:150





Second one is the wall on the west side, that is made of metal - 10 IPE200 profiles and one metal plate with 45 gaps formed to make a playful shadows - exciting atmosphere. We decided to work with metal, because it is a material that through the time will corrodes . Passed time that will stay noted on the wall.


The third element are the stairs made from metal, that circle around the postament and gives monumentality and introduce a third dimension to the space.

Each of these elements has its own meaning with his construction and form. The monument represents the past with his actions. The wall will represent the time that will come and the stairs are representing current developments.


